As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed."

♦ John 8:1-12

"And when they had set her in the midst, they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned. But what do You say? So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, "He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first. When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her, "Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you?" She said, "No one, Lord."
